

Pupil Premium

Pupil Premium is a payment from the Government which is in addition to the main school budget. The money is allocated to schools to support children who are from low-income families and who:

- are known to be eligible for Free School Meals
- have been looked after (in the care of the Local Authority) continuously for more than six months
- have parents currently employed by the Armed Forces

Schools are free to spend Pupil Premium funding as they consider appropriate to most benefit the needs of their pupils. From September 2012 all schools are required to publish on their website how Pupil Premium funding has been spent and what impact this has had on pupil progress and achievement.
